## How to Access Agentadvisor



To perform tasks in Agentadvisor, you need to log in to the system.

The writing agent/producer at your organization will have a unique login and password.

## First Time Visit

For those new to Agentadvisor, you will receive a welcome email from sales@sanfordhealth.org with the Subject: Sanford Health Plan Agent Portal. From the link in the email, you will set your password. You will use the username given in your welcome email and the password you set to access Agentadvisor. In many cases this is your direct email, however some users may need a variation (addition of .shp to your email) so pay special attention to your welcome message for your specific username.

If you do not receive the welcome email, please reach out to your dedicated Account Manager or sales@sanfordhealt.org for a password reset.
